



3.16.2016 Pennsylvania may become the 24th state to legalize Medical Marijuana

On Wednesday, March 16, 2016 The Pennsylvania House PASSED an amendment to their previous position on the Medical Marijuana Bill.

Governor Tom Wolfe has indicated that the Bill will soon be approved.

This Bill would allow patients, with ****qualifying conditions**, to use and safely access medical cannabis with their physicians' recommendations.

The ****qualifying conditions**, at this point in time, include cancer, HIV/AIDS, multiple sclerosis, seizures, autism, sickle cell anemia, and intractable pain if “conventional” therapies or opiates are contraindicated or ineffective.
