Labor Poster Changes

Effective February 2017, the “**Wyoming Health and Safety Protection on the Job**” Notice will be revised to reflect an increase in the mandatory penalties per serious and non-serious violation, daily penalties for failure to correct, and an increased total violation cap. The current maximum penalties of up to \$7,000 for each violation of serious and non-serious violations will increase to \$12,741 per violation. The current “Failure to Abate” violation will also increase from \$7,000 each day beyond the abatement date for each violation to \$12,471 per day. “Willful” and “Repeat” violation penalties will both increase from up to \$70,000 per violation to up to \$124,709 per violation.
